ISRAEL – HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

As a freelance designer, he founded ARDEA srl, Architettura Design Ambiente firm, in 1994 in Lecco. Mr. Montanelli is specialized in coordinating and developing feasibility studies, planning, recovery plans. He develops mitigation measures and safeguards on environmental issues, landscape architecture, development of disused areas coupled with the recovery of buildings industrial archaeology (i.e., study of environmental and landscape compatibility, simulation and monitoring, coordination of engineering design phase). He is a designer of different civil works, hotels, single-family villas, apartments, lofts, spas and wellness centers, restaurants, and showrooms. He is specialized not only in designing new structures, but also the refurbishment of many others, which are subjected to architectural or environmental restrictions.
